



# Green Highway



## The Green Highway - from coast to coast

A thousand-year-old trading and pilgrimage route crosses Scandinavia, connecting the Atlantic with the Baltic coast. Three cities, Sundsvall, Östersund and Trondheim, in collaboration with Jämtkraft and other energy companies, plan to create a green highway along this route. Environmentally sustainable fuel will be available along the highway and drivers of electric vehicles will be able to charge their car batteries. Some of these services are already available. Two places have biogas pumps, and along the highway there are around 20 filling stations that sell ethanol fuel. This year a string of charging stations will be established, allowing electric vehicles to recharge their batteries along the entire highway. The Green Highway Project also includes plans to create an urban winter testing centre for electric and other environmental vehicles in Östersund.
